Children are welcome at park events with some aimed at children and some at adults or families, if unsure please ask. At all events please ensure that under 16's are accompanied by an adult at all times.

Very occasionally we may need to cancel an event at short notice. We will try to contact everyone who has booked to inform them of this. We reserve the right to cancel an event if we have received no bookings or if bad weather is forecast.
